I call on you to meet, face to face, with Detention Action and Families for Justice.

Families for Justice are a group of mothers, wives, partners and daughters directly affected by UK's cruel and unjust deportation policies.

Your companies are making money by forcing families apart and harming children, including those of Families for Justice members. It is only right that you should answer to them and hear what they have to say.

Since 2012, of the people facing deportation who were supported by Detention Action, more than half faced being separated from their children as a result.

Unrecognised numbers of children have been harmed when your planes suddenly and permanently took one of their parents, siblings or grandparents away. The true number is still unknown because the UK Government does not record how many children are affected by their policy.

Your flights tear families apart.

Your flights leave children vulnerable, traumatised and even suicidal.

Your flights transform happy families into single parent households, overnight.

Your flights force families into poverty.

Families for Justice simply want to understand how you justify your involvement in these racist and unjust mass deportation flights.
